WATER AND SEWER BILLS

Please do not place cash in the door slot.

By paying your water and sewer bill before the end of the "grace Period" you can avoid paying a \$20.00 late fee.

Please notate the invoice# of your water and sewer bill on your check when paid.

There is a \$15.00 fee for any check returned by the bank for insufficient funds,

For the fee of \$197.50 per quarter each property owner is allotted 20,000 gallons of water. If you go over the 20,000 there is an added charge. Please check for possible leaks. Even a slight leak in a toilet or a drippy faucet can add up.
