Please do not place cash in the door slot.

By paying your water and sewer bill before the end of the "Grace Period" you can avoid paying a \$20.00 late fee.

*Please notate the invoice# of your water and sewer bill on your check when paid.*There is a \$15.00 fee for any check returned by the bank for insufficient funds.

For the fee of \$197.50 per quarter each property owner is allotted 20,000 gallons of water. If you go over the 20,000 there is an added charge. Please check for possible leaks. Even a slight leak in a toilet or a drippy faucet can add up.
